

## Director of Music at St Oswald's, Norbury

Following the retirement of the current post holder we are looking for an inspiring and dedicated **Director of Music** who will play the organ and lead and develop our small but enthusiastic robed choir, which is augmented for special services and festivals. Working in conjunction with the Vicar, you will further develop and shape the musical life of this vibrant Parish.

The regular duties are currently a weekly Sunday morning Sung Eucharist (which is an All-age service on one Sunday each month), weekly choir practice, and additional services on the major feasts. We are looking for someone who is comfortable playing in services where old and new hymns happily co-exist. Talent-spotting and enabling others in playing instruments would also be helpful.

We hope there might be potential for music to be a means of development and outreach for our church, and would support the creation of a children's or community choir, and the involvement of other musicians.

St Oswald's is a welcoming church and this is a rewarding post, in a Parish where the contribution of all types of music is greatly appreciated.

Starting from September 2018 with the possibility of an earlier start if required

Remuneration and terms and conditions are in line with RSCM recommendations. There is the opportunity for additional fees from occasional weddings, funerals and potentially music lessons. In recent years there have been approximately five weddings and ten funerals each year.
